Introduction:

C-Quest Capital is a social impact investment enterprise based in Washington D.C., USA. We leverage carbon finance to provide the investment capital necessary for our stove programs to be carried out through partnerships with like-minded development organizations that use their networks of staff and trainers to reach the target households. To date, CQC through implementation partners has built over 750,000 stoves worldwide, with operational hubs in Malawi and Zambia, and have planned expansion efforts in 2021. Our investment program for 2021 is to provide an additional 3 Million Stoves over the next ten years across nine Sub-Saharan Countries.

At this end, we are working with ENEDOM (Energie Domestique) as our liason and implementor for the first round of project implementation that will install 14,000 stoves by April 2021 before planing for next phases.
